Guidelines for submitting articles.

- 1. AMBC members, members of other societies and members of the public are encouraged to either write articles or to supply material for publication by AMBC.
- 2. Material supplied will be subject to editorial guidelines as above.
- 3. If an article is subject to significant editorial change it will not be published without the author's consent.
- 4. Photographs are an important feature of most articles. The minimum requirement is that they should be in focus. The editorial team will invariably use digital enhancement where necessary.
- 5. Some authors prefer to remain anonymous and should make that clear when offering material for publication.
